SUBJECT: FROM ADAM to CHRIST

The Means - Faith

Galatians 3:26. For ye are all the children (sons) of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

John 5:24. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that <u>heareth My word, and believeth</u> on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation, but is <u>passed</u> from death unto life

The Means - The Holy Ghost

John 3:5, 6. Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:13. For by <u>one Spirit were all baptized</u> into one body, whether we be Jews or Greeks, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

Galatians 3:26. For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Union with Christ

By faith, we are united with the Lord Jesus Christ; through the work of the Spirit of God. Having been united with/in Him, we share in His death, burial, resurrection, ascension and rest:

His Death - Our Death

Romans 6:3. Know ye not that as many of us as were <u>baptized into Jesus were baptized into His death</u>?

Galatians 2:20. I am <u>crucified with Christ</u>; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

His Burial - Our Burial

Romans 6:4. Therefore, we are buried with Him by baptism into death; that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

His Resurrection – Our Resurrection

Romans 6:5. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection.

Ephesians 2:5. Even when we were dead in sins, hath <u>quickened us (made us alive) together with Christ</u> (by grace ye are saved).

His Ascension - Our Ascension

Ephesians 2:6. And hath <u>raised us up together</u> and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

His Seat – Our Seat (to rest and to reign)

Ephesians 2:6. And hath raised us up together, and $\underline{\text{made us sit together}}$ in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 4:3. For we who have believed do enter into rest, as He said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into My rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Ephesians 1:20 – 22. Which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set him at His own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come; And hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church.
