

“God’s Word, Alive!”

The first chapter of the Epistle to the Hebrews contains seven quotations from the Old Testament. *These quotations, which are prophecies, speak of the exalted GLORIES of the LORD JESUS CHRIST. As is true of prophecy, these quotations have an immediate and a future application and fulfillment. But, prophecy’s chief purpose is its application to Christ Himself. In Hebrews Chapter One, the Holy Spirit, reveals from the Old Testament scriptures, the superiority of Christ over angels and that He was and is worthy of the highest honor and reward.*

The first quotation speaks of the supremacy of Christ, as “Son,” superior over angels. (*verse 5*)

The second quotation speaks of the unique relationship of the Son to the Father. (*verse 5*)

The third quotation speaks of the superiority of Christ by the angels worship of Him. (*verse 6*)

The fourth quotation speaks of the eternal Son, who is better than created angels. (*verse 7*)

The fifth quotation speaks of the throne of the exalted Christ. (*verses 8 and 9*)

The sixth quotation speaks of the Son’s work in creation. (*verses 10 – 10*)

The seventh quotation speaks of rest after a finished work (Genesis 2:3), and so this quote views Christ as now seated at God’s right hand as the reward of His finished work. (*verse 13*)

You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness more than Your companions.”	Psalms 45:6, 7 Your throne, O God is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You love righteousness and hate wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness more than Your companions.
6.	Hebrews 1:10 – 12 And: “You, Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will fold them up. And they will be changed. But You are the same, And your years will not fail.”	Psalms 102:25 – 27 Of old You laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You will endure; Yes, they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will change them, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will have no end.
7.	Hebrews 1:13 But to which of the angels has He ever said: “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool?”	Psalms 110:1 The LORD said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool”
