> WISDOM and the GODHEAD

As revealed in scripture, wisdom is manifested in each Person of the Godhead:

God, the Father

- Romans 1:33. Oh, the depth of the riches both of <u>the wisdom and</u> <u>knowledge of God</u>! How unsearchable are His judgments, and His ways past finding out!
- 1 Corinthians 2:7. But, we speak <u>the wisdom of God</u> in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory.

God, the Son

- 1 Corinthians 1:30. But, of Him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification and redemption.
- Colossians 2:2, 3. That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of <u>Christ, In whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom</u> and knowledge.

God, the Holy Spirit

 Isaiah 11:2. And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him <u>the spirit of</u> <u>wisdom</u> and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

> JOB'S SEARCH FOR WISDOM

Job 28:12 – 28.

¹²But <u>where shall wisdom be found</u>? and where is the place of understanding?
¹³Man knoweth not the price thereof; neither is it found in the land of the living.
¹⁴The depth saith, It is not in me: and the sea saith, It is not with me. ¹⁵It cannot be gotten for gold, neither shall silver be weighed for the price thereof

¹⁶It cannot be valued with the gold of Ophir, with the precious onyx, or the sapphire. ¹⁷The gold and the crystal cannot equal it: and the exchange of it shall not be for jewels of fine gold. ¹⁸No mention shall be made of coral, or of pearls: for <u>the price of wisdom is above rubies</u>.

¹⁹The topaz of Ethiopia shall not equal it, neither shall it be valued with pure gold.
²⁰Whence then cometh wisdom? and where is the place of understanding?
²¹Seeing it is hid from the eyes of all living, and kept close from the fowls of the air.
²²Destruction and death say, We have heard the fame thereof with our ears.

²³God understandeth the way thereof, and he knoweth the place thereof. ²⁴For he looketh to the ends of the earth, and seeth under the whole heaven; ²⁵To make the weight for the winds; and he weigheth the waters by measure. ²⁶When he made a decree for the rain, and a way for the lightning of the thunder: ²⁷Then did he see it, and declare it; he prepared it, yea, and searched it out. ²⁸And unto man he said, Behold, <u>the fear of the LORD, that is wisdom</u>; and to depart from evil is understanding.

- Wisdom cannot be bought
- Wisdom is of more value than precious stones and jewels.

Its location

- Wisdom is not located in earth
- Wisdom is not located in the depths
- Wisdom is not located in the sea
- Wisdom is hidden from man
- Wisdom is hidden from the fowls

Its fame

• Destruction and death know of wisdom's fame

Its source

• Wisdom is found in God, alone

Its definition

• Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom

> WISDOM'S ATTRIBUTES AS DESCRIBED - PROVERBS 8:1 - 21

¹Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice? ²She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths. ³She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors. ⁴Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice is to the sons of man. ⁵O ye simple, <u>understand wisdom</u>: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.

⁶Hear; for <u>I will speak</u> of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things. ⁷For my mouth shall <u>speak truth</u>; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips. ⁸All the words of my mouth are in <u>righteousness</u>; there is nothing froward or perverse in them. ⁹They are all plain to him that understandeth, and right to them that find knowledge. ¹⁰Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.

¹¹For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be <u>compared to it</u>. ¹²<u>I wisdom</u> dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions. ¹³The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate. ¹⁴<u>Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am</u> <u>understanding; I have strength</u>. ¹⁵By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.

¹⁶By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth. ¹⁷I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me. ¹⁸Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness. ¹⁹My fruit is <u>better than gold</u>, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver. ²⁰I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment: ²¹That I may cause <u>those that love me</u> to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.

JESUS CHRIST is WISDOM - PROVERBS 8:22 – 31

²²<u>The LORD possessed me</u> in the beginning of his way, before his works of old. <u>²³I was</u> <u>set up from everlasting</u>, from the beginning, or ever the earth was. ²⁴When there were no depths, <u>I was brought forth</u>; when there were no fountains abounding with water.

²⁵Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth: ²⁶While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world. ²⁷When he prepared the heavens, <u>I was there</u>: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth:

²⁸When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep: ²⁹When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth ³⁰Then <u>I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him;</u> ³¹Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights were with the sons of men.
