

**THE SEVEN TRUMPETS – Revelation 8 and 9**

**EXERCISE: From your Bible, what is the answer to each of the following questions?**

1. Revelation 8:2 – What will be the position of these seven angels?
2. Revelation 8:2 – What will be given to the seven angels?
3. In Revelation 8:3 – 5, complete the following items to see what things must happen before the seven angels can sound their trumpets.
4. Revelation 8:3 – Who will come on the scene?
  - What will this angel have?
  - What will be given to him?
  - What will the angel do with the incense?
5. Revelation 8:4 - What will also be offered along with the incense?
  - To whom will the smoke of the incense and the prayers ascend to?
6. Revelation 8:5 – What will the angel take from the altar and put in the censer?
  - What will the angel do with the censer?
  - What will be the result of the censer being thrown to the earth?
7. Revelation 8:6 – Now that the actions of verses 2 – 5 are complete, what will the seven angels prepare to do?
8. Revelation 8:7 – What will come to the earth when the first trumpet sounds?
  - What percentage of the trees will be burned up?
  - What percentage of the green grass was burned up?
9. Revelation 8:8, 9 – What will come into the sea when the second trumpet sounds?
10. What will be the three results on the earth?
11. Revelation 8:10, 11 – What is the name of the star that will fall from heaven when the third trumpet sounds?
12. What will happen to many people?
13. Revelation 8:12 – What will happen to the sun, the moon and the stars when the fourth trumpet sounds?
14. Revelation 8:13 – What is the message of this angel regarding the next three trumpets which are yet to sound?
15. Revelation 9:1 – 12 is “The Fifth Trumpet” and “The First Woe.” After reading this passage, why do you think it is a “woe?”
16. Revelation 9:13 – 21 is “The Sixth Trumpet” and “The Second Woe.” After reading this passage, why do you think it is a “woe?”
17. Revelation 11:15 is when the “The Seventh Trumpet” will sound. It is “The Third Woe.” Read Revelation 12:12 to see what will be in this seventh trumpet to make it exceedingly “woeful.”
